Illness

Q. What happens if a player a player suffers an illness that involves neither an injury nor bleeding eg toilet stop, cramp, nausea, and breathlessness, as well as asthma.

A. - The player must either continue play immediately, or concede the game in progress and take the 90-second interval between games to recover.

- Only 1 game may be conceded. The player must then resume play, or concede the match.
- If a player's vomiting or other action causes the court to become unplayable, the match is awarded to the opponent.
